Subj: Required Use of the LDMS Reagent Logging Module

The purpose of this memo is to remind laboratories on the usage of the LDMS Reagent Logging Module. The reagent logging module is used to track reagents used in the laboratory and uses a defined set of reagent codes. The module will record the Lot number, expiration date, manufacturer and start/end dates. The LDMS has recently expanded the reagent module to the web-LDMS, in addition to the previously available windows version. It is the expectation of the ACTG and IMPAACT that ACTG and IMPAACT laboratories use the LDMS Reagent Logging Module. Please see attached guides on how to use the LDMS Reagent Module.
